Parking

I would like to thank everyone very much for the way that you have adopted the new parking procedures at the end of the day which we have been trialling over the last two weeks.

Traffic now moves very freely with the result that we do not have any cars at all queueing onto Long Lane. This has never happened before. Children, parents and other road users are now very safe and there is no need for anyone to spend a long time waiting to collect their children. The buses are able to collect completely safely. Staff are able to supervise and look after the children very easily. The whole process of handing children over to their parents at the end of the day has become a really good one. In short, I believe that the trial has been a great success. Thank you. It would not have worked without the active participation and cooperation of every family.

In light of the above, I now intend to continue this system. Please continue to observe it and help it work as you have over the last two weeks.

In order to help parents to maintain social contact, the PTA will be running their coffee and croissants mornings regularly, so look out for the date of the next one. Also, the staff will be planning more occasions for you to come into school to see what your children are doing (along the lines of the gym club display and the Mothers' Day assemblies). Please do come to any which are relevant to you.

I am also very pleased that the school signs on the roads have been re-located to more suitable positions and that the area around the school has been designated a 'school zone' with advisory 20mph speed limit. This is great news. I would like to thank Josie McLachlan for her work in bringing this about, and anyone else who has been involved. The staff, governors and I will continue to look into additional safety measures and let you know about these in due course.
